Action taken Report

- 1. The internal academic audit for 2019-20 was conducted with the audit team and 1160 no. of books were purchased, One major UGC project was brought by a teacher and 10 research papers in the different journals and book chapters were published by teachers and 6 add-on courses each of 30 hrs. were started in this session.
- 2. Internal administrative audit (Financial audit) was done with an internal audit team and Procurement of Solar Lamp Posts with solar panels and battery system, installation of LAN networking were done apart from buying instruments, furniture and maintenance charges.
- 3. The installation of Solar light and installation of dust bins are proposed by IQAC for a clean and green campus initiative and these were installed in this session.
- 4. Development of rainwater harvesting systems and recharge are also proposed by IQAC.
- 5. It has been decided that to reduce the use of plastics, placards bearing tags like plastic free zones should be placed at different focal points.
- 6. IQAC has proposed all departments to maintain students' records and to prepare Departmental annual reports.
- 7. Methods of continuous assessment as prescribed by NAAC have been discussed and it is decided to take in the form of viva, MCQ, quiz, presentation etc. on regular duration like weekly or biweekly.
- 8. Due to Covid period and lockdown classes are going on online mode from April 2020. IQAC has also proposed all departments to activate students through different online programs such as covid awareness, essay writing, poster competition etc.
- 9. Seminar and symposium committees are instructed to conduct various webinars.

- 10. CAS documents of Dr. Sushanta Kumar Maity and Dr. Nilay Kumar Maitra were checked and IQAC started the procedure for their CAS screening.
- 11. IQAC also tried to sensitise the stakeholders to integrate cross-cutting issues like gender, health and environmental sustainability. Awareness programmes along with seminars on Water conservation, Post humanism and research methodology were organised.
- 12. 4 lectures were organised under Faculty exchange Programme via MOU collaboration with Jhargram Raj College this year for betterment and knowledge development of students. 2 lectures per college were organised under Faculty exchange Programme via MOU collaboration with GGDC, Mohonpur, Jhargram Raj College Girls Wing, GGDC, Lalgarh, GGDC, Narayangarh, GGDC, Gopiballavpur II and GGDC, Kharagpur II.
